



## OVERVIEW

These notes summarize a portion of the discussion from the Let's Bee Telepathy YouTube channel [video \*Beyond Words, Beyond Earth: Telepathy, Plasma, and Hidden Knowledge\*](#), recorded July 17, 2025 and uploaded March 1, 2026.

The segment begins with a question from Anne Marie referencing the book *A New Science of Heaven*, which explores plasma physics and discusses the discovery of two enormous plasma clouds located near the Moon. Anne Marie asks whether “Owen,” communicating telepathically through Melissa Jolly Graves (MJG), can offer insight into the nature or purpose of these plasma structures.

In response, Melissa Jolly Graves, Telepathic Communicator (MJG) relays Owen’s perspective that plasma and water together play a central role in the emergence of consciousness and structure in the universe. The explanation suggests that plasma by itself has no stable form or memory, but when it interacts with other substances—particularly water, and possibly certain hydrogen structures—it can generate patterns, structure, and organized energetic systems. In this view, plasma acts as an initiating force, while water provides a medium capable of holding memory and organizing information.

Throughout the exchange, MJG periodically pauses to clarify or interpret what she is receiving telepathically, noting that some of the concepts being conveyed are complex and difficult to translate into ordinary language. The discussion touches on several related ideas, including the role of gravity in shaping plasma structures, the possibility that plasma interacts with matter to create patterns in natural systems, and speculative connections to phenomena such as orbs, holographic images, and energetic structures within the human body.

Later in the conversation, participants briefly discuss how plasma might create visible phenomena—such as light rays, halo effects, or holographic-like images—when it interacts with other substances. The dialogue closes with MJG acknowledging that the concepts being communicated are expansive and difficult to fully articulate in the moment.

Overall, the exchange explores a speculative framework in which plasma is described as a pervasive energetic medium that interacts with matter—especially water—to enable structure, pattern formation, and possibly aspects of consciousness.



### Clarified Transcription from video:

**Anne Marie's Question:** Okay, so there's a really good book called *A New Science of Heaven*, written by an expert in the field of plasma physics. The whole point of the book is to talk about these plasma clouds that have been discovered on either side of the moon. If you imagine the Earth below, the moon above, and these two plasma clouds that are on either side, and they're absolutely enormous.

The people who discovered them weren't actually looking at them from the perspective of them being plasma clouds. The whole book talks about how science never seems to acknowledge that we are made of 99.9% plasma, and so is everything else, and that all consciousness and intelligence is made up of plasma.

So it's just really interesting that these clouds are there. I was hoping by the end of the book that he was going to say a bit more about why they were there and what their connection was. But he just put a few things out there and didn't really come to any conclusions. So I'm just wondering what Owen might can share about that.

### Melissa Jolly Graves (MJG)– Communicating telepathically for Owen:

**Owen conveys:** So consciousness—yes, plasma does need to be a part of it, as does water. Especially within our atmosphere - those are the two things we are looking at.

**MJG Interjects:** That's not an exact study that we are doing with Veda. A lot of that information also has—but also obviously has that information. So we just want to say Elsa is our cloud expert, but she's not here, so we're going to go ahead.

It's just out of respect for her that I'm like, she's the cloud expert.

**Owen conveys:** We're not particularly talking about plasmic clouds. We're talking about plasma in itself in a gravitational pull that brings itself into an electric component in the way that it starts to have structure.

**MJG Interjects:** So he's showing that plasma, when it gets into a gravitational pull, will start to have structure. Plasma in itself is very destructive, so it will try to rein itself in. As it tries to rein itself in—oh my gosh, this is really complex. Hang on. Give me a moment so that I can get the right words before I start talking. Every avenue I'm going to, he's going in different places. Thank you.

**Owen continues to convey:** Plasma itself has no structure. Plasma has the ability to tap into anything, but it does need limits. Otherwise it is something explosive that could hurt and would not be conducive for the whole.



So that's where water comes in. Water, gives plasma a place to have full expression as water. Plasma can reach into every aspect of itself, but water allows that to hold memory, adaptation, and the real consciousness within that.

It is not within the plasma that consciousness is—rather, plasma has to spark the water. Water does not have consciousness itself until it has plasma. The two of them have to go together. That's where consciousness lies. That's where we need to be looking when we talk about consciousness, the limitations consciousness has, and the organization consciousness holds.

What I mean by the limitation of consciousness is the structure that plasma has. No matter if it's glass or—hydrogen components that can happen,

**MJG interjects:** but I don't know how they work in our world. But he is very specific that there are certain hydrogen components that, if the molecules are set a certain way, can hold plasma also.

**Owen continues to convey:** Now on water - plasma always needs to be contained to have energetic structure.

**MJG interjects:** The forward thinking—he's using language I don't know, so I'm going to say “forward thinking” would be the best way. Which means to me something different than it means to him.

What he is showing is that plasma, when it is alone, is just a gas. It has no structure. It doesn't bounce off itself like normal things. It's odorless and colorless—there's nothing there.

When another substance comes into place—water, or glass, or hydrogen—plasma is always attracted to those substances. He's showing how when you put your hand near plasma, it comes through the hand. Plasma will always want to connect with the things around it.

**Owen continues to convey:** Once that connection happens, plasma expands, then pulls itself in and reconstructs its energy. When it pulls itself back in to reconstruct the energy, it has already tapped into the outside.

Now when it brings itself in, it starts an energetic structure of a pattern source that lays out ways of thought—how the universe will be, how rain will fall, how urine will end up. We're going into many different things.

But plasma needs something to hold it. Gravity and inward reflection start the structure and place energetic lines where electromagnetic energy moves so that energy can follow.

Now, because plasma is odorless and sightless, it doesn't follow patterns like we do.

**MJG interjects:** This is really complex.



**Owen continues to convey:** Although water can evaporate and get outside of itself, it always returns to itself. Plasma can lay out a path and keep going out. It can slip outside water, slip outside the mind, slip outside other things, and it doesn't necessarily return to itself.

If something else picks it up at the core, it will return back to that thing and reconfigure the coding happening within it.

**MJG interjects:** So it's almost like plasma holds information, but until it touches something it can't structure the information. It doesn't have structure alone, so it needs something else.

Plasma can't hold memory. It can adapt, but it doesn't hold information the same way other things on Earth do. He's saying it's the universal key to get into anything. There are places where there's no water, no sun, no whatever—but there is no place where there isn't plasma.

And Owen, please don't get us on another project.

Yeah, that's our next big project, right?

Then he's going into the structure of the human body. The human body has plasma in it, and now there's structure.

He's talking about angels, orbs, and how they can do teleportation through plasma. But it doesn't hold their structure because it has to change the further it is from the source.

There is so much going on right now. Plasma—like—I don't even know how to explain it the way he is explaining it, because there are not words or structures for it that I know.

I'm going to end there because I'm overwhelmed. I'm being honest. Sorry. They're usually really good, but this is like—whoa.

#### **...Conversation continues when Tara asks about orbs:**

Well, orbs appear as a container - Otherwise it (plasma?) would just be dispersed gas.

**MJG interjects:** But still, it has structure. Even light does this. Owen is saying light contains structure too. If you have light, it wants to build structure. That's why you see rays of light—they always have halos and lines.

#### **Conversation continues regarding holograms:**

**MJG interjects:** Okay, I know you brought up holograms earlier, but I can talk about that.

Plasma, especially when it has structure, can mimic and create images and reflections. A lot of times you were talking about plasmic beams where people see holograms—that's a real thing.



That was plasma emulating light in a structured way because it knew how to mimic once it had a substance to touch so it could self-reflect.

Okay, there we go. That was plasma emulating light in a structured way because it had something to reflect off. That made a little more sense put that way.
