SUMMARY

The three documents outlined and linked in this overview trace a single arc: They cover how my process, the Beaver Moon ceremony, and the autists' water teachings all fit together to shape the upcoming New Moon work and ceremony I'll create for 11/19/2025.

WHY CERMONIAL TIMING MATTERS & THREE LAYERS OF UNDERSTANDING

- 0. Why Timing Matters: This linked document provides context around why the timing of our ceremonies matter that we synthesized after exploring the Austic Water Teachings presented by Veda Austin.
- 1. Document A: Lori's Process Meets the Autists Water Teachings

This first document establishes the foundation. It shows:

- How Lori's process actually works: noticing \rightarrow Forge \rightarrow Point of Prophecy \rightarrow Sanctuary \rightarrow earth-plane application.
- How that process mirrors the autists' descriptions of water as a transducer, a doorway, and a carrier of planetary tone and meaning.
- The striking alignment between the shoreline ceremonies I do and the way water responds to intention, frequency, geometry, and emotion.



Where this leaves us: The ceremonies I create are not symbolic reenactments. They participate in a real field of planetary communication. With them, we are already positioned inside the same architecture the autists describe: water as a medium of consciousness.

2. Document B: What the Beaver Moon Ceremony Actually Did

The second document applies this lens to our 11/06/2025 Beaver Moon Ceremony. It explains, in direct language, what happened inside the field.

It shows the Beaver Moon ceremony:

- Tempered the New Moon inheritance into structure—making insight usable.
- Created coherence between fire and water in my system and the group field.
- Aligned you with the Golden Current, which the autists describe as water's coherent state.
- Rewove wounds into protection and belonging, and
- Reset the relational field among kids, caregivers, seen/unseen allies, the land, and the sea.
- Integrated the Golden Dragon, not as a symbol, but as a guardian of coherence.
- Seeded the winter season with warmth, clarity, and gentle power.

Where this leaves us: We are entering the next ceremony already standing inside coherence, safety, belonging, and an active shared field. This New Moon we are stepping into a conversation already underway.

3. Document C: How This Shapes the New Moon Ceremony

The third document translates everything into practical next steps.

It shows that the New Moon ceremony (11/19–20):

- Builds on coherence already established it does not need to clear or stabilize first.
- Uses water's responsiveness to tone, attention, and geometry to give form to what you opened.
- Shifts from healing into creation, from holding space into shaping it.
- Moves safety → structure, resources → flow, trust → connection, cleansing → integration, and "making space" → actual invitation.



Where this leaves us: The next ceremony isn't to clean up debris, it is focused on forming, structuring, and inviting the next pattern:

- Golden Dragon current
- Coherent rhythms
- Joy as navigation
- Partnership with the water

- Dialogue with the kids' collective
- Planetary harmonics
- Safety as the new baseline

This New Moon is a **receiving event**—a doorway in the same way <u>the Austic Water Teachings via Veda Austin</u> show that hydrolyphs are doorways. (See this overview on why timing and content matter at the New Moon.)
