



OVERVIEW

The **Bridge to Vision Circle**, a sanctuary of safety and a laboratory of wonder, convened for the first time on November 11, 2025, to begin building what Lori described as a *bridge of delight*—a living pathway of communication between parents, caregivers, collaborators, and their children who express across the spectrum of verbal and nonverbal experience. Guided by Lori’s efforts to bring forward architectural clarity and balanced by Diane’s quiet enchantment, the group gathered in safety and reverence to explore how this communication can unfold with greater ease, grace, and clarity. Through shared stories, intuitive resonance, and heartfelt intention, they began shaping a new field where understanding flows in both directions—between worlds, between hearts, and between forms of expression.

1. Opening Context

- **Early start:** Lori and Carrie met first due to a time zone mix-up; others joined around the 40-minute mark.
- **Tone:** Warm, exploratory, deeply reflective — blending personal storytelling with spiritual inquiry.
- **Lori’s acknowledgment:** She noted her natural pace is fast-moving and that she’s learning how to move in a way that remains *safe, digestible, and sustainable* for everyone.
- **Numerical symbolism:** The meeting date, 11/11, was recognized as carrying a sense of destiny — a signal of alignment and new beginnings.

2. Opening Dialogue (Lori & Carrie)

Carrie:

- Shared birthday reflections — joy in small gestures from her son, **Asi**, who had gifted her a plant and a drawing.
- Noted Asi’s recent progress: relaxing more, communicating more, and completing self-care tasks independently.
- Appreciated Lori’s writing and insights, acknowledging they take time to absorb amidst many active circles.

Lori:

- Spoke about a “crisis of confidence” — the challenge of translating intuitive flow into grounded form.
- Introduced the concept of “**thread tone**” — the idea that words carry vibrational frequencies understood beyond language, possibly resonating with non-verbal individuals like Asi and Stacy Lee.



- Reflected on how her creative words and poems might be channels of frequency communication shaped by emotion and sound.

Shared insight:

- Both sensed that the group's children may perceive or even *orchestrate* these connections at a frequency level, guiding how and when communication unfolds.
- Emphasis emerged around safety, trust, and pacing as sacred conditions for authentic exploration.

3. Safety and Confidentiality

- Lori raised **Kelly's concern** about protecting her and her daughter's identity following past trauma.
- The group agreed: personal names, likenesses, and identifying details will not be shared beyond trusted circles.
- The language of "the kids" will be used publicly to protect privacy.
- Consensus: *Safety is the foundation of the Bridge to Vision Circle.*

4. Carrie's Story and Spiritual Context

- **Background:** Originally from New York, now in Israel. Mother to Amit (39) and Asi (35, autistic and highly sensitive).
- **Asi's journey:**
 - Suffered trauma a decade ago in a workplace setting; withdrew completely for several years.
 - Found renewal through a spiritually attuned therapist who visited him at home.
 - Gradually began to reengage — communicating, accepting touch, showing signs of inner healing.
- Telepathic collaboration:
 - Works with **Naomi**, a therapist using telepathic dialogue and meditative triads.
 - Carrie described luminous energetic experiences during sessions — flashes of light, feelings of clearing.
 - Plans to undergo a *Dolores Cannon-style regression* to ask her higher self questions about communication with Asi.
- Spiritual understanding:
 - Views Asi as a high-level spiritual being and energetic balancer.



- Believes he may place thoughts in her mind (“I want to go to Naomi”) as a form of intuitive direction.
- Speaks of “groups” or collectives of souls that the children belong to — each working at a different energetic frequency.

5. Shared Understanding Between Lori & Carrie

- Both sensed that **the children may be coordinating the connections** forming among parents and allies.
- The smaller circle could serve as a *laboratory of coherence* — a place to deepen understanding before wider engagement.
- They acknowledged the need to balance mystical openness with tangible grounding.

6. Arrival of the Full Circle

As **Diane**, **Kati**, and **Kelly** joined, Lori paused to re-center the group.

Collective intention round:

Each member named what they most wished to feel by the end of the meeting.

Participant	Desired Feeling
Kelly	Coherence
Diane	Gentle quiet inside
Carrie	Joy in being together
Kati	Connection
Lori	Integration of all these feelings into a shared field

Lori framed the moment as a braid of intentions — coherence, quiet, joy, and connection — drawn together on this symbolically charged date of 11/11.



7. Participant Introductions

Carrie:

- Reiterated her earlier story for the full circle, focusing on Asi's healing and their telepathic triads.
- Emphasized the theme of *"the kids getting us together"* — an invisible coordination she finds beautiful and mysterious.

Kati:

- From Budapest; mother of **Máté (24)**, non-verbal with epilepsy and frequent seizures.
- Discovered *Suzy Miller's Telepathy Tapes* through the *Gene Keys* and felt a strong call to join this work.
- Expressed that, beyond helping her son, the circle supports *her own unfolding* — becoming more authentic and present.
- Founded a small organization to explore community-based living for adults like her son.
- Feels her life bridges cultures and communities; grateful to bring that bridge energy here.

Kelly:

- Mother of **Stacy Lee (18)** — described as radiant, strong-willed, and profoundly intuitive.
- Shared her daughter's path: early speech, later regression, eventual communication breakthrough using *Spelling to Communicate (S2C)*.
- Recounted trauma disclosure during adolescence and the long process of rebuilding trust.
- Described energetic symbols emerging around Stacy Lee's presence — a **blue heart**, **butterfly**, and **dragon eye**, each representing transformation and awakening.
- Framed the circle as "the A-Team," where each member brings a unique superpower toward healing and connection.

Diane:

- Set her intention as *gentle quiet inside*. Her calm presence is welcomed to ground the group's expanding energy
- Recognized by Lori and the others as carrying the **energy of enchantment** — the one who brings energetic sensitivity, wonder, playfulness, and natural rhythm to the circle.
- Invited to be seen as the *keeper of grace* who counterbalances Lori's architectural weaving with intuitive ease.



- Has long experience working with children and families, giving her insight into developmental and emotional landscapes.

8. Collective Insights and Resonances

- The group reflected that **connection itself is a form of healing** — for both parents and their children.
 - Kelly described physical sensations (chills, warmth) as confirmations of truth or resonance.
 - Lori observed that belonging and shared coherence may mirror what the children seek internally.
 - The group sensed a *guiding intelligence*— their children collectively—creating the “bridge” between seen and unseen communication.
 - Shared imagery: golden threads of light, hearts, frequency, music, and tone weaving through everyone’s stories.
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9. Holding the Field: Summary of Intentions

As the meeting drew to a close, Lori invited everyone to replace traditional “action items” with **intentions**—energetic commitments that would shape what each person would carry forward.

She proposed three initial intentions:

1. **Safety** — to protect the emotional and energetic wellbeing of everyone involved, including the children.
2. **Sourcing/Resources** — to invite abundance and the right forms of support, both material and spiritual.
3. **Anchoring Sanity** — a shared commitment to trust that their work, though unconventional, is meaningful and grounded.

Kelly affirmed this, urging the group to remove the word *insane* from their vocabulary, reframing it as a **heart-led journey guided by divine trust**. Trust then became the fourth collective intention, viewed as the positive form of that “no insanity” anchor.

Kelly linked this to the *Telepathy Tapes* series, noting a growing alignment between scientific understanding and the energetic experiences of their group. She spoke of drawing attention and resources—“*the right people*”—who could help them carry this vision into practical form. Her intention was to let the work attract the support it needs while staying centered in **super love**, not the pursuit of “superpowers.”



Lori then described her **symbolic gesture**, tracing a Spiral that moves “*up and to the right*,” echoing her late friend Kent’s expression of growth and possibility. For her, it signifies *abundance of resource, abundance of trust, abundance of safety—all of it, abundance*.



Kati (added her personal intention: to heal lingering **guilt** and create **inner and outer cleansing**—to make space for what brings her alive and benefits her, her son, and the wider world.

The group received this warmly, and Diane offered to hold a **healing session** as it felt right, reflecting the mutual care emerging in the circle.

Lori closed by promising to **write a poem** to capture these intentions:

- Safety; resources; trust; cleansing and integration; making space for the new

She proposed that everyone sense intuitively when to meet again, to which Kelly shared that she asked her daughter Stacy Lee what she thought—and heard the message:

“Be fun.”

The group laughed, agreeing that this was the perfect guidance. “*Don’t worry about scheduling the next thing—just be fun*,” Lori echoed, sealing the meeting with laughter, gratitude, and love.

11. Observed Group Dynamics – Do they fit? Make yours...yours 😊

Participant	Observed Role / Energy
Lori	Visionary architect and facilitator; holds the structural weave and spiritual inquiry.
Carrie	Seasoned traveler and heart anchor; brings wisdom from lived experience and deep maternal resilience.
Kati	Bridge-builder across geographies and modalities; grounded and reflective, bringing cross-cultural perspective.
Kelly	Firekeeper; catalyzes emotion, voice, and transformation; channels heart energy through vivid storytelling.
Diane	Keeper of enchantment and balance; her grounded stillness softens the architectural edges of the weave, linking imagination, grace, and the felt presence of children.



12. Closing

- Carrie had departed early for her birthday dinner; the group celebrated her and the day's symbolic alignment.
- Kelly described the moment as “jumping off the old wheel” — stepping together into a new field of creation.
- Lori closed with gratitude and the sense that the Bridge 2 Vision Circle had officially taken form as both a sanctuary of safety and a laboratory of wonder.
